Project TOTTS (Together Our Tots Thrive & Survive) works in collaboration with the Broward Healthy Start Program, providing comprehensive prenatal and infant educational and empowerment program. Project TOTTS supports families in reducing the factors and situations that place pregnant women and infants in jeopardy for poor outcomes.
