Student Internship Program Description:

Urban League of Broward County's Student Internship Program (SIP) is a 12-week immersive unpaid internship program placing undergraduate and graduate students in placements working alongside program and administrative staff throughout the organization.

Interns will have the opportunity to work on a variety of projects that advance their department's work to better serve underserved communities. In addition, interns will have several professional development opportunities throughout the semester. These include Senior Management Brown Bag Discussions and networking with the Young Professionals Network.

Essential Functions and Job Responsibilities

Urban League Youth Programs are designed to increase positive decision making in middle school students in an effort to reduce risk factors associated with substance abuse, teen pregnancy, delinquency, and school failure. This is a great opportunity for someone interested in youth development, education, and social work to experience a successful program in action.

- Assist staff with the planning and execution of summer program for middle school students.
- Plan fun, creative, and engaging activities for youth.
- Assist teachers with facilitating activities and monitoring classrooms.
- Monitor students throughout the day, including in classrooms, during bathroom trips, mealtimes, and more.
- Chaperone field trips.
- Provide administrative support, including assisting with sign in/out sheets, data entry, filing, processing applications and more.
- Other duties assigned by Supervisor.

Work Environment

This job operates in a professional office environment, off-site venues and outside areas in various weather conditions. This role routinely uses standard office equipment such as computers, phones, copiers, filing cabinets, and fax machines.

Physical Demands

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand, walk, sit use hands, handle or feel, reach with hands and arms stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl, and talk or hear.

Position Type and Expected Hours of Work

This is a part-time intern position (15-25 hours per week). Days and hours of work may vary; however, the company's business hours are Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

- Exceptional undergraduate and graduate students are invited to apply and must have a current minimum GPA of 3.0.

- Must be comfortable interacting with youth and can establish appropriate rapport.
- In addition to academic success, the Urban League seeks individuals who are committed to making a difference in their community, exemplify leadership in both traditional and non-traditional ways, and are willing to work hard.
